

# The Project

Schools across the UK are invited to take part in the Junior Filmmakers Film Competition for Schools 2020.

The schools will be divided into two categories- Junior schools and Secondary schools. 10 young people will represent each school. They will be taken through the Junior Filmmakers training program and learn theme, character, story development, script drafting, camera use, pre-production-scheduling, budgeting, crewing, casting then onto filming and video editing.

Each school will select a film-making lead who will receive training from Junior Filmmakers and be the lead contact and trainer of the young people in their school.



Junior Filmmakers will provide mentorship, guidance, training material and all equipment required for the successful implementation of the project in each school.

All the trainers and managers of Junior Filmmakers are DBS cleared filmmaking professionals and or trainers.





The films made by the participating school/groups could be a documentary, a musical film or a narrative fiction.

The films will be judged by a panel which will comprise of film industry professionals.

The films produced will be premiered and judged regionally. The regional winners will be judged at a national film premiere in London where the national winner will be announced.

Other categories such as 'best actor/actress' will also be announced.

Winners will receive 360 degrees camera equipment and a VR kit for the school.
